Capitol Wireless Integrated Network (CapWIN) – Washington, D.C.

- Public safety and transportation agencies in D.C., Virginia, and Maryland will share data through the CapWIN switch.
- CapWIN will also provide new wireless services and integrate existing systems.

Integrated Incident Management System (IIMS) – New York City

- A USDOT field operational test, IIMS is a multi-agency incident management system that will – in real time – transmit incident messages that will include text, locations, and images.
- IIMS links incident responders in the field and operations centers, coordinating both public safety and public works incident response and management.

Transportation and Emergency Services Communications Network (TESCNET) – Milwaukee

- A pilot project will link the MONITOR Freeway Traffic Management System with county and state law enforcement computer-aided dispatch systems.
- The pilot project will be the cornerstone of a regional communications network in the Milwaukee area to connect transportation and public safety agencies.
